Challenges/Protests A fee of \$3 will be charged for each challenge, which will be returned if the challenge is met. All competitors are advised to check their posted scores after the completion of a match

Rules Current CMP rules will govern. Competitors are responsible for the knowing the contents of all current rules. Competitors will score, work target pits, and assist range personnel as required. The match director reserves the right to modify the course of fire and/or pit rotations based on the number of shooters, weather, and range conditions.

Chamber Flags An Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) is required to be inserted while on Greenwood Gun Club property except during the preparation period or actual firing (rule 10.1.1). Upon firing the last shot the ECI must be reinserted, and the magazine removed before the competitor gets out of firing position. The rifle must be removed from the firing line with an ECI in place. ECI's are available for purchase

Targets SR at 200 yards, SR-3 at 300 yards, MR-1 at 600 yards

Scoring All firing will be on electronic targets. Competitors' must bring smart phone, tablet or other device to allow accessing the Electronic Scoring

Electronic Targets EIC Match- Electronic Target use will comply with CMP High Power Rifle Rules – 25<sup>th</sup> edition. Target Centers will be used

Rifles: No Muzzle Breaks allowed.

Service Rifle - Rules 4.1...

Ammunition No bullet with a diameter greater than 308 inch will be allowed. 55 grain .223 is not allowed at 600 yards. Tracer, incendiaries, armor piercing ammo is not permitted. Ammunition must be safe. Bullets must remain supersonic at the target and the match director will have right to remove the competitor/ammunition from the line if the bullet is not supersonic. Any ammo that repeatedly blows primers or splits cases will be ruled defective or unsafe and the competitor/ammunition will be removed from the firing line. Any competitor that cannot stay on target will removed from the firing line. The match director can remove any competitor from the firing line if he rules the rifle, ammo or competitor is unsafe.

Coaching Coaching is not allowed

Challenge Period The challenge period will end 30 minutes after the completion of each match. All awards and scores are tentative until publication of the official match bulletin. A jury will resolve protests.
